#### 1 / Introduction

The Regional Focal Point

The first point of contact for the region to provide information on the BEST 2.0+ programme and its call for proposals

BEST 2.0+

❖ BEST 2.0+ is the continuation of the BEST initiative and BEST 2.0

The overall objective of BEST 2.0+ is to promote the conservation of biodiversity and sustainable use of ecosystem services, including ecosystem-based approaches to climate change adaptation and mitigation, as a basis for sustainable development in OCTs.

The specific objective is to enable, empower and strengthen local authorities and civil society organisations which are committed to local development, biodiversity conservation and sustainable use of ecosystem services in OCTs through the implementation of a grant scheme accompanied by the capacity building activities.

A two-stage call for proposals:

### Overall information on BEST 2.0+ Grants







#### Financial allocation and grant amount

- ⇒ BEST 2.0+ Call for proposals total budget : €1,300,000
- A maximum of €60,000 per BEST 2.0+ grant
- The budget should reflect the expected results, activities and related costs. It is not necessary to request the maximum amount
- ! Co-funding is not allowed

#### **Grant duration**

- \* A maximum of 19 months
- Duration should be aligned with the activities and workplan
- ! No extension will be granted



## Eligibility criteria







Applicant's eligibility

- UK OCTs' organisations are eligible
- ❖ Applicants must be: a private or public legal entity; registered in one of the European OCTs\*; directly responsible for the project; have a bank account in the name of the organisation
- Target beneficiaries are primarily: local NGOs and non-profit organisations; micro-enterprises; local sub-governmental bodies
- Individual consultants, sole traders and consultancy firms are not directly eligible but can be sub-contracted
- Special conditions apply to uninhabited territories and OCTs with low population (following slide)
- The lead applicant may act individually or with co-applicant(s)
- ❖ An organisation can submit a maximum of two proposals but can only be awarded one grant as lead applicant
- ❖! A research organisation can only apply as co-applicant, provided that the applied research supports tangible actions





Special conditions for uninhabited Territories

Exceptional access allowed for:

- ❖ Territorial governments departments, agencies and their services
- Organisations that are based in the region (but not regional organisations)
- Organisations based in a EU Member State or the UK
- ▶ ! In the two later cases: the applicant must demonstrate the support from the relevant OCT authorities

Special conditions for OCTs with a low population

Exceptional access allowed for OCT territorial governments and their services when:

❖ There is a low population, i.e. < 60 000 inhabitants and a population density < 100 pop/km²</p>

#### And

The project puts a strong emphasis on the territory (collaboration with local stakeholders, capacity-building)

#### Eligible criteria

Eligible activities must:

- ❖ Be located in one of the EU or UK **OCT**s
- Comply with IUCN environmental and social safeguards
- Contribute to tangible impacts on conservation, sustainable development / use of biodiversity and ecosystem services
- Encourage partnerships with local stakeholders
- Guarantee open access to data, results and all information generated by the project
- Not be fundamental research activities





#### Eligible criteria List of potential activities



- Improving the status of OCTs' threatened species and their habitats;
- Vegetation/habitat mapping for supporting tangible activities on the ground of protection and/or restoration of critical habitat;
- Strengthening Protected Area management and/or governance effectiveness (training, new/updated PA management plan, participatory activities);
- Support to local stakeholders' initiatives (e.g., local communities and authorities) to help protect/manage biodiversity, ecosystems (e.g. ecosystem management, participatory monitoring);
- Analysis to better understand/quantify the threats on biodiversity for supporting new tangible activities
  on the ground;
- Socioeconomic studies for supporting the development of new sustainable economic valorisation of biodiversity, ecosystems and ecosystems services (e.g. ecotourism);
- Mitigation of specific threats such as climate change impacts, invasive alien species;
- Traditional solutions promotion and deployment in terms of sustainable management and biodiversity conservation;
- Local and participatory circular economy solutions preserving ecosystems and reducing pressures on biodiversity;
- Sustainable agricultural and fisheries good practices promoting species and habitat conservation; agroecological activities (including agroforestry);
- Public awareness, education campaigns, socio-cultural activities, training and capacity building;
- Support to local stakeholders' enhanced participation to biodiversity and sustainable development (e.g. participatory monitoring, eco-sentinels).

- ❖ The deadline for the full proposals will be indicated in the notification letter of preselection





- \* 8 questions about the project's context; objectives; relevance to BEST; activities; timeline; risks and resources; partnerships and stakeholders; sustainability and added value; rough budget estimate
- ❖ 5 Environmental and Social Management System (ESMS) Preliminary Questions
- Once fully completed, it should be uploaded online



# **Evaluation**

#### 6 / Evaluation

- Proposals will be examined by the Regional Advisory Committee
- ! Only the concept notes with a score of at least30 will be preselected
- Applicants will be informed in writing about the results of the concept note evaluation

Criteria	Maximum Score
Does the project make a clear demonstration that it is concretely addressing the BEST 2.0+ objectives?	5
How relevant is the proposal to <b>local</b> and <b>national</b> strategies, and the BEST Regional Ecosystem Profile? <sup>2</sup>	5
Are the foreseen activities relevant and tangible enough for achieving the overall objective? Do they present positive impacts during its lifetime?	10
Is there already a clear approach for the sustainability and replicability of the project?	5
Does the proposal contain particular added-value elements?  To which extent does the proposal integrate elements such as promotion of gender equality and equal opportunities, people with disabilities and youth participation, rights of minorities?	5
How coherent is the overall design of the project?  Does the proposal indicate the expected results to be achieved? Does the intervention logic explain the rationale to achieve the expected results?	10
Are the workforce and timeline realistic? Are the activities feasible and consistent in relation to the expected results (including timeframe)? Are results realistic? Does the design take the risks into account?	5
Does the project identify all relevant partners and their capacities? How clearly defined and strategically chosen are those involved?	5
